POLICY

- Physical facilities such as Buildings of the institute and Laboratories will be maintained from the funds allocated by the General Council in its General Budget and grants received from various sources such as State Government, RUSA, World Bank assisted project MPHEQIP (Madhya Pradesh Higher Education Quality Improvement Project) as per the requirements.
- Laboratories will be maintained and upgraded from the funds available in the General Budget. The proposal about the maintenance or up gradation will be moved by the Head of the concerned department. This proposal will be monitored by the Construction/Maintenance Committee. The final approval may be granted by the Director as per the allocation and availability of funds.
- The Institute will outsource the housekeeping as per the standard norms of the MP Purchase Rules.
- The water sources will be regularly checked and maintained by the plumber of the Institute.
- Chemistry Laboratory of the Institute should comply to neutralization mechanism. No Chemical waste should be discharged directly without neutralization into the drainage to avoid deterioration of the soil quality of the Institute.
- The Institute will be responsible for solid waste management inside the campus and would avail the services of the Municipal Corporation for the same.
- All the drinking water points and ROs of the Institute should be maintained by the plumber and supplier of the machines through AMC on regular basis.
