



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

#### 5 JUNE 2020 Plant a tree, Plant a breadth






JULY 26, 2021. Kargil Vijay Diwas.







### August15th ,2021. Independence Day.

complex where running, push ups and high jumps were evaluated and written test was conducted under the guidance of ANO Dr Manish Sharma.




## October 28,2021. Cleanliness Rally On Plastic Use Awareness.

### **Detail of the Extension Activity**

- An extension activity was organized in the village of Bairagarh chichli by the department of Food Science and Quality Check. The health checkups of the residents of the village was conducted. Some of the check-ups that were done are Hb, BMI(body mass index), blood pressure. This was done under the surveillance of DR. GORVA (MBBS) and SAWRNA(Technician).
- An awareness Program was organised for the formation of SHG(self help group). PRAKASH HATWALNE imparted the knowledge about the importance of Self Help Groups and their roles, duties. They were also taught how these SHGs can be created and become an asset for the villagers.
- 3. Another extension activity was organised in Bairagarh chichli. In this extension activity, the villagers were taught about the preparation of soaps, detergents, and floor cleaner at home. This activity taught skills to the women and they can be financially independent.
- 4. Another extension activity for the students of primary school was organized. The students organised a game play activity for the young ones.
- 5. In village Borda an extension activity was organised for the villagers. Here the residents were taught about Preservation of the Food and Processing pickling, rose water and Preparation of chips were demonstration.
- 6. In village Borda house hold methods of detecting adulterants in food commodities were explained in the year 2020-2021. This activity was conducted to create awareness about the adulterants that are highly toxic for the body. These toxins can lead to health issues like heart failure, liver disorders, kidney disorders, etc.

### **Tarang**

It is the cultural fest of the Institute where students display their skills and talents and receive suggestions and approvals from judges and guests. 
