In module II - Parallel economy in India added and Evaluation of new economic policy in Global perspective deleted.

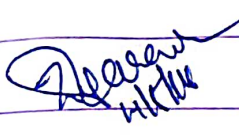
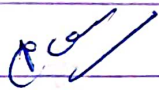
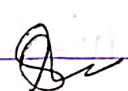
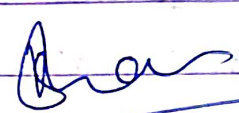
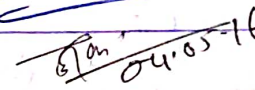
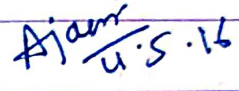
